This is a 12-week paid summer internship, which will begin in May 2023 and will wrap up in August. All candidates must be able to work full-time hours in Clayton, NC for the entirety of the internship to be considered.

Job Responsibilities

- Follow all safety procedures on the job site and report incidents immediately
- Shadow Operation Managers and Coordinators
 - Attend construction meetings
 - Read construction drawings
 - Document daily crew activities and safety checks
- Work alongside grading/utility crew
 - Load and unload construction materials from trucks both manually and with the use of equipment
 - Clean and prepare construction sites as needed, removing and properly disposing of debris and waste materials, etc
 - Operate heavy equipment, as needed
 - Lay water, sewer and storm drain pipe according to construction drawings and specifications
- Travel out of town to work on remote job sites as directed by management

Physical Requirements

The physical demands described are representative of those that must be met by a Field Engineer to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.

- Regularly required to sit and/or stand during a regular work shift of at least eight hours per day
- Ability to work long periods of time outdoors in all weather conditions
- Occasionally required to stoop, bend, walk, crouch, and climb
- Ability to lift and carry, on a frequent basis, at least 50-90 pounds
- Exposure to dust, dirt, grease, and noise
- Frequently walk on uneven surfaces including natural ground and slopes in varying weather conditions

- Pursuing an undergraduate degree; Construction Management, Civil Engineering, or relevant field preferred
- Must pass pre-employment drug screen and background check
- Highly motivated, challenge-driven, and entrepreneurial
- Strong ability to demonstrate leadership and interpersonal skills

- Willingness to work in a team environment
